

Wednesday, October 7th, the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation announced a second phase of the “We’re All In” Small Business Grants. Grants of \$5,000 are available this time, if you remember the grants were \$2,500 the first time.

Applications will be accepted starting at 8:00 am on Monday, October 19th through Monday, November 2, 2020. The application will be available at [revenue.wi.gov](https://www.revenue.wi.gov) and you can request assistance at (608) 266-2772.

To be eligible you must have:

- Been in business prior to January 1, 2020 and operated in 2020.
- Have more than \$0 and less than \$1 million in gross revenues.
- Have 1 to 50 full-time equivalent employees in 2019.
