We just received information this morning that Wisconsin has a new grant available for small businesses. The following information came in an email from the Wisconsin Department of Revenue.

The **Wisconsin Tomorrow Small Business Recovery Grant** program will award \$420 million to small businesses impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic through a collaboration between the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation (WEDC) and the Department of Revenue (DOR). The new grants, which will be funded by the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), are intended to support those businesses who were hardest hit by the pandemic and are key to Wisconsin making a strong recovery.

Grants of \$5,000 are available through this program to Wisconsin businesses with more than \$10,000 but less than \$7 million annual revenues.

Applications for the **Wisconsin Tomorrow Small Business Recovery Grant** program will be accepted from 8:00 a.m., Monday, May 24, to 11:59 p.m., Monday, June 7, 2021.
